

New Member Code of Ethics Training Requirement

By signing this document, I understand that my obligation for REALTOR® membership includes completing a “New Member Code of Ethics Orientation” and providing the Board Office with documentation of **completion within 30 days of the date of this application**. This membership requirement can be met by taking the course online at the National Association’s website, free of charge.

First, you will be issued a NRDS (National REALTOR® Database System) number which will allow you access to NAR.realtor. Please register on this site with your NRDS number as your ID and then create your own password.

When this training is completed correctly, you will receive a certificate, and you must provide a copy of that certificate to the Board Office.

Should I not complete this requirement, my provisional REALTOR® membership status will change to a “non-member” status in which I lose my rights as a REALTOR®, to include, but not limited to the dues being higher, I lose my voting rights with the Association, and cannot use the term REALTOR® or REALTORS®.
